



Here are some Travel details that might be useful.

Amma's programme is at the National Show Centre, very near Dublin Airport.

Transport to the National Show Centre:

By Bus www.dublinbus.ie phone 01 873 4222

To and from Dublin city centre:

No. 33 from Lower Abbey Street, Dublin city centre

No. 41 from Lower Abbey Street, Dublin city centre

No. 41 a, b, c from Lower Abbey Street, Dublin city centre

No. 33, 41, and 41c operate approx every 15 minutes, from about 5.000 until 23.30.

To and from Malahide

No. 102 Malahide via Swords & Coachmans inn (show centre stop)

Operates every 45 minutes, from 06.55 until about 22.20.

Coming from Dun Laoghaire (Ferry port):-

No. 746 goes to and from **Dublin Airport**.

This bus operates from 08.00 until 20.30 from Dun Laoghaire, and from 09.15 till 21.45 from Dublin Airport, at hourly intervals.

Coming to/from Connolly or Heuston Railway Stations, Dublin :-

No. 747 operates from Central Bus Station (Bus Aras, near Connolly Station) to **Dublin Airport**.

Operates from 06.45 until 22.50, approx every 10 to 20 minutes.

No. 748 operates to/from Heuston Station via Central bus station to

Dublin Airport.

Operates from 07.15 until 22.20, every 20 to 30 minutes.

From Jurys Hotel, Belfast to Dublin Airport, from 06.30 until 20.30.

This coach operates at hourly intervals.

From Ballsbridge/Donnybrook area, Dublin to Dublin Airport,

operating 24 hours, every 10 or 20 mins, depending on time of travel.

From Leopardstown/Sandyford area to Dublin Airport, operating 24

hours every 10 or 20 mins, depending on time of travel.

To/From Dalkey to/from Dublin Airport, via glasthule, Dun Laoire, Monkstown, Blackrock, Ailesbury rd, Dublin Airport.
Operates from 4am to midnight, every hour

To/From Portlaoise, Kildare, Red Cow, Dublin Airport
Operates from 04.30 to 22.30, every 2 hours.

By car from Dublin City Centre: Take the M1.

From West and South – at end of M50, head on to M1.

On M1, take Airport / Swords slip road/exit.

Come to Airport roundabout.

Take the 3rd exit off roundabout.

Go past the Coachman's Inn pub on the right.

After the Coachman's Inn, you will come to Cloghran roundabout.

Take the 3rd exit off the roundabout.

A few yards down this road, turn left, into the National Show Centre.

Directions from Dublin Airport to Amma's programme venue: National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin:

By Bus: 5 to 10 min bus ride. Bus No. 33, 41 and 41c, operate from city centre to Swords, via Dublin Airport.

Take bus 102, 41 or 41b, at Dublin Airport. Make sure the bus is going in direction of Swords. Get off after 2 stops (5 mins), at the Coachman's Inn pub. With the Coachman's Inn on your right, walk on a short distance to Cloghran roundabout. Take the 3rd exit off the roundabout. A few yards down this road, turn left, into the National Show Centre.

By car or walking: 5 to 10 mins drive, 30 minute walk

Exit from Airport building, and turn Left.

Follow flow of traffic, and pass petrol station on left.

Stay in left lane if driving.

You will come to traffic lights at big roundabout.

Take the 1st exit off the roundabout (R132, N1 to Swords).

You will travel past the Coachman's Inn pub on the right,

After the Coachman's Inn, you will come to the Cloghran roundabout.

Take the 3rd exit off the roundabout.

A few yards down this road, turn left, into the National Show Centre.
